UPGRADES FIRE CODES FOR A SAFER COMMUNITY

Congratulations Village President Diane Hiller and Clarendon Hills Trustees!

On August 21, 2000, the Village of Clarendon Hills passed an ordinance requiring all new single-family homes to be protected with a residential fire sprinkler system following the NFPA 13D standards. In addition, all new multi-family, residential, and townhomes will require fire sprinkler protection. The ordinance also requires all new commercial buildings to be protected regardless of size with the exception of business, mercantile, and storage occupancies under 2,500 square feet. To date, Clarendon Hills has a total of 360 single-family homes protected by a residential fire sprinkler system.

As a result, Clarendon Hills has become a fire safe community protecting those who live, work and visit there. It also helps safeguard the firefighters who respond to the incidents.
