LAGRANGE PARK UPGRADES FIRE CODES FOR A SAFER COMMUNITY

Congratulations Village President Dr. James L. Discipio and La Grange Park Trustees!

More than four years ago, the Village of La Grange Park passed an ordinance requiring all new single-family homes to be protected with a fire sprinkler system following the NFPA 13D Standard. The ordinance also requires all new commercial buildings to be protected with fire sprinklers regardless of size except occupancies classified as business, mercantile and storage facilities, which must be 2,000 square feet or larger.

By upgrading their codes, La Grange Park has become a fire safe community protecting those who live, work and visit there. It also helps safeguard the firefighters who respond to the incidents.
