OAK FOR EST UPGRADES FIRE CODES FOR A SAFER COMMUNITY

Congratulations Mayor JoAnn M. Kelly and Oak Forest Aldermen!

On July 11, 2006, the Oak Forest City Council passed an ordinance requiring all new commercial buildings, regardless of size, to be protected with a fire sprinkler system. This ordinance also requires apartment-to-condo conversions and large nightclubs with occupancy loads of 200 people or more to be retrofitted with fire sprinkler systems. In addition, all new construction single-family homes and those with additions of 60% or more of the original square footage will require fire sprinkler protection following the NFPA 13D standard.

As a result, Oak Forest will become a fire-safe community protecting those who live, work and visit there. It will also help safeguard the firefighters who respond to the incidents.


