UPGRADES FIRE CODES FOR A SAFER COMMUNITY

Congratulations Chief Mark Duski, Deputy Chief Bill Tauchen and the Villa Park Village Board!

On August 14, 2006, the Village of Villa Park amended its building and fire code to require residential quick response fire sprinklers, following the NFPA 13D standard, in all new single-family homes and town homes. In addition, all new commercial construction over 1,500 square feet is required to be protected with fire sprinklers.

As a result, Villa Park will become a fire safe community protecting those who live, work and visit there. It also helps safeguard the firefighters who respond to the incidents.
