## UPGRADES FIRE CODES FOR A SAFER COMMUNITY

### Congratulations Village President Billie D. Roth and Streamwood Trustees!

In 2002, the Village of Streamwood amended their building and fire code to require residential quick response fire sprinklers, following the NFPA 13D standard in all new homes and those that renovate over 50% of the property. To date, almost 970 homes are fire sprinkler protected with no slow down of building. In addition, all new-commercial properties, including multi-family apartments and condos over 1,000 square feet are fire sprinkler protected.

As a result, the Village of Streamwood has already seen the benefit of a residential sprinkler save and a number of commercial sprinkler saves. Not only has Streamwood become a fire safe community protecting those who live, work and visit there, it has taken a proactive step to improve fire fighter safety by the installation of automatic sprinklers.
