CONGRATULATIONS VILLAGE PRESIDENT AL LARSON AND THE SCHAUMBURG VILLAGE BOARD!

The Village Board of Schaumburg is to be congratulated for maintaining a high degree of fire safety for present and future residents and visitors by updating its building and fire codes using the 2009 Editions of the International Building (IBC), Fire (IFC) and Residential (IRC) Codes. The Board recognized the importance of updating the codes in order that all new single-family homes now will be fire sprinkler protected using the NFPA 13D standard. Schaumburg joins 73 other Illinois communities and fire districts that have adopted progressive fire sprinkler ordinances for single-family homes to provide the highest level of protection for residents.

The code updates also further solidify Schaumburg's previous fire sprinkler requirements for high-rises and commercial buildings, as well as townhomes and multifamily apartments and condominiums.

The trustees and members of the Schaumburg Village Board should be proud of their long tradition of fire safety, protecting their community now and into the future.
