In an effort to increase fire safety and protect its citizens, the Village of Chicago Ridge worked closely with Chief Randall Grossi and the Chicago Ridge Fire Department to pass a "zero tolerance" fire sprinkler ordinance in December 2007, making Chicago Ridge a Fire Safe Community.

The ordinance requires fire sprinklers in all new commercial construction and in all new single-family homes following the NFPA 13D standard of installation.

As a result, Chicago Ridge will become a truly fire safe community protecting those people who live, work and

visit. It also helps safeguard the firefighters who respond to emergency incidents.
