To provide an improved minimum standard for the safety and protection of Lake Zurich citizens and firefighters, former Fire Chief Terry Mastandrea, current Fire Chief David Wheelock, and Assistant Fire Marshal Guy Trayling worked closely with the Village of Lake Zurich Board of Trustees to amend and update building and fire codes to the 2006 editions of the International Building (IBC), Fire (IFC), and Residential (IRC) Codes. These newly adopted standards further solidify Lake Zurich's commitment to utilize fire sprinkler systems as lifesaving elements for multifamily residential, commercial, and high-rise structure that have been inherent in the community's development since 1997.

All new single-family homes will now be protected with fire sprinklers using the NFPA 13D standard, joining 75 other Illinois communities that provide the best technology available for fire- and life-safety protection for residents.
