FIRE SPRINKLER DEMO TRAILERS:

SEEING IS BELIEVING.

The best way to convince people how effective fire sprinklers are is to show them. That's why the Illinois Fire Inspectors Association (IFIA) and Northern Illinois Fire Inspectors Association (NIFIA), along with the Northern Illinois Fire Sprinkler Advisory Board (NIFSAB), offer four fire sprinkler demonstration trailers for use by fire officials and fire safety advocates. Use them at village, city, or district board meetings, training events and public education events.

Each trailer is equipped with quick-response residential fire sprinkler systems, which may be supplied by a tank and pump and/or through an FDC and hydrant connection/engine hose line feed. NIFSAB generally tows the vehicles to the site, but in some situations you may need a tow vehicle with a Class III hitch. The fire sprinklers are supplied by NIFSAB. A generator is also available (upon request) for reservation with the trailers.
