The Village of Roselle has announced that local business owners are eligible to apply for a new grant program funded through American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds. The grant program assists Roselle businesses recovering from COVID-19 pandemic impacts. Funding can be used toward code compliance and fire protection/suppression systems among other improvements. Businesses can receive a maximum of \$10,000 with a 50/50 cost share.

Roselle Mayor David Pileski and Fire Chief Mark Bozik note the program will help keep Roselle business owners, employees, residents, visitors and first responders safer. This grant program will assist the village's economic growth and development after a trying time during the pandemic. It provides businesses with funding to tackle projects they have identified as critical for long-term success and safety. It also helps the village prevent tax revenue loss caused when a business is closed due to fire.
